Master of Construction Management (MCM)

Brief Program Details: MCM is an interdisciplinary STEM program focused on management of construction projects interdisciplinary studies in commercial, residential, heavy/highway, and industrial applications to address a broad range of challenges facing the construction management field.

Qualification:

- Under graduate degree (B.Tech /B.E.) in Civil Engineering / other core branches. (Candidates appearing at the 8th Semester Examinations can get provisional admission).
 - Basic requirements for Masters unconditional admission: GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale; GRE (Quant) ≥ 155 ; TOEFL ≥ 79 or IELTS ≥ 6.5 . These are general requirements and are not strictly followed in every case.
 - No deficiency courses for applicants with a non-Civil Engineering background
- Note:** Applications are received for admission based on overall student's performance. Students with work experience can apply for a GRE waiver.

Scholarships: Some candidates may qualify for partial scholarship as per UTA norms.
